In just a few weeks we will celebrate Easter with the wonderful proclamation of Resurrection life beyond the grave, death has been defeated through the death and Resurrection of Jesus Christ. Some may ask preacher how can you be so sure of that? It comes with knowing the risen Christ!

The central message of the Resurrection is not that it is simply the promise of the future life in eternity with Christ, rather the resurrection is the way of living I the present. The Resurrection says Christ is alive and because he is, we can experience his presence and power in our lives today.

The resurrection says Jesus Christ is not simply a memory, but a presence. Not just someone to discuss, but someone to meet.
